Pen y Clogwyn is an old crofter's cottage that dates back to at least 1800, and probably 1600.

Owned by the [Wessex Mountaineering Club](http://www.wessexmc.org.uk) since 1981, the hut has been sympathetically renovated throughout.

During 2009/2010 the hut has undergone a major renovation with new kitchen units fitted and replacement of the gas lighting system with electric lights.

Just a ten minute walk up a track in the forest above **Betws y Coed**, the hut has been used by Wessex club members, other clubs, the armed forces, company team building groups, and a multitude of individuals and small parties.

There is good access to the **Snowdonia National Park**, and opportunities for **climbing**, **walking** and **mountain biking**.

A **lounge** with a number of easy chairs arranged around the wood burning stove, and a dining recess that contains a large dining table and benches.

The **kitchen** has a gas cooker, ample food storage space, a fridge, pots and pans and all the cutlery known to mankind.

Sleeping is in bunks both in the hut on a raised platform (6 spaces), and in the adjoining bunkhouse (12 spaces) giving a total of 18 places.

The **toilet block** has a drying room, shower, toilets, and washing basins.

Outside there is, a stream, trees, a wood shed, and a wonderful sense of solitude.
